What is the Building Tomorrow campaign?

Building Tomorrow is a capital campaign to raise the funds necessary to secure a more permanent facility for Aspire Church. Since our start in 2013, we have been meeting in schools, but since God has grown Aspire Church, it is time to have a place we can call home.

What is the goal of Building Tomorrow?

Where will Aspire Church meet?

While we have not identified a specific facility, we are looking at a number of potential properties. Aspire Church will remain in the Surprise/El Mirage community. God has been opening possible opportunities for Aspire to acquire a facility, but we need the capital necessary to make that happen.

Why is this the right time?

God has grown Aspire Church in maturity, in grace, and in size since our beginning. The first group of people that met to dream and plan about what would become Aspire Church started with 23 people in a living room. Today we have over 200 people on campus every weekend. We offer services in two different languages, and we have a thriving children's and student's ministry. We believe that God will continue to grow our ministry, but we need more appropriate facilities to accomplish this important work. Of course, we do not believe that a church is its building, but a building is a bridge to bring new believers to Jesus.

What will the new building be like?

While we don't have a specific facility in mind, whatever it is, and wherever it is, it will meet 3 distinct requirements.

- First, it will be a glory to God. No church should be a palace designed for its people, but a temple for God. Our building will be a space that honors God, in how it's used and how it's treated.
- Second, our facility will be for the community. We will have open doors so the community can use the building as necessary and appropriate. We want this facility to be a light of grace to our community. Our dream is to have a place that provides for both the spiritual needs, but also the physical needs of our city.
- Third, it will be a home. A place that we are proud to call home and excited to walk in those doors.

Of course, any facility will match our [5 purpose statements](#): To proclaim Christ to those who need him; To show God's love by how we care for each other; To be the most generous church we can be; To be a source of grace to our community; and To grow one step closer to Christ each day.
